

CIA USING L3 COMMUNICATIONS AS SECRET LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY

Apache Attack on Egyptian Citizens

At least 3,000 employees of a private United States military contractor, L-3 Communications, reported by credible Federal law-enforcement sources to be a rogue CIA front with its own fascist agenda, are back on the job after a 6 day strike at Apache Attack Helicopter training base, Fort Rucker, Alabama. The Apache Attack Helicopter is among the most fearsome weapons systems in the United States military arsenal and has been deployed in Iraq and Afghanistan.

L-3, which operates under multiple umbrella names, settled the strike during collective bargaining with the International Association of Machinists Union (IAM). Union members provide logistical field and operational support services to the US Army and USAF training fleet of attack helicopters. According to confidential Federal law enforcement sources, L-3 apparently settled the strike to prevent media exposure ahead of pending litigation and charges of Genocide in the Karjina region of Croatia.

The tentacles of L-3/MPRI, the organization charged with Genocide, reach far deeper into little-known companies. **For example L-3/MPRI has a protégé partnership agreement with an Enterprise, Alabama company, Navigator Development Group.** The Navigator Development group is led by Retired US Army Colonel Albert Patterson, Jr. III, whose grandfather was assassinated during the clean-up of organized crime in Phenix City, Alabama, during the '50s. This organization is one of the multiple private off-the-books-vendors for the Apache Attack Helicopter.

Most significant is the organization's location---116 South Main Street in the Rawls Hotel building, a place dubbed as the "Lobby" by John McCain's former campaign manager. The contract is for domestic spying, surveillance, intelligence for international law enforcement agencies and the US Central Intelligence Agency.

The Lobby Tipster - John McCain's former Campaign Manager?

The Lobby tip came shortly after the 2008 federal court deposition of Mike Connel in a Columbus, Ohio elections fraud case against Karl Rove, George Bush, Dick Cheney concerning manipulation of nationwide results in the 2004 Presidential race. Connel a pilot and "Republican Party White House IT Manager," was reportedly a frequent visitor to the Lobby in Enterprise.

Connel gave the deposition in late 2008 and the testimony was sealed because Connel was to appear again after the 2008 election. Connel expressed fear for his life and before he could provide follow-up testimony he died in a nighttime fiery airplane crash at Akron, Ohio when his plane was 3,000 feet shy of the airport runway.

A careful investigation reveals multiple documented criminal acts committed by L-3 and MPRI. These criminal issues raise serious national and domestic security issues American citizens must immediately investigate during these turbulent times. Since 1992 an on-going multi-state investigation by Insider-Magazine.com conducted on a quid-pro-quo basis with Federal and state law enforcement agencies reveals that the umbrella organization known as L-3 has deliberately ignored laws. L-3 has become part of a larger world-wide apparatus, promoting and implementing a fascist agenda like that of the banned Wartime National Socialist Party (NAZI) in Germany.

Credible law enforcement sources believe that L-3 Communications has been deployed by the CIA under various cover names to Spy on the FBI in Mobile, Birmingham, Alabama, and Jacksonville,

Florida offices of the FBI as well as other United States intelligence agencies since the middle 1970s. The complaints and problems with L-3 span several years; some go back as far as before the year 2000 and continue today. Insider- Magazine.com's research will show how they have accomplished their goals to commit acts that weaken the United States by setting up a virtual police state of constant surveillance.

We acquired our information from personal experience, including quid-pro-quo investigations with Federal and state law enforcement spanning almost three decades, government documents (POGO), legal documents related to the lawsuits filed against L-3, and letters from government agencies to L-3 regarding their dirty practices.

Genocide

L-3 and its subsidiary company MPRI are cited as "providing the means by which the genocide of 200,000 ethnic Serbs occurred." Until August 1995, the ethnic Serbs lived in the Krajina region of Croatia. Survivors and family members of the assault have filed a Federal Genocide lawsuit in Illinois, case No: 1:10-CV-05197. This forty-page suit, which is currently on hold, details the atrocities committed upon the men, women, and children who became victims of the 1995 Croatian military assault known as Operation Storm. The operation was an aggressive, systematic military attack, a bombardment on a civilian population that had been placed under the protection of the United Nations. According to the lawsuit MPRI/, L-3 trained and equipped the Croatians who committed the senseless killing of over 200,000 people----because the civilian Serbs were of a different religio-ethnic group. The suit asks for \$25,000 per person x 200,000 people, totaling \$5 billion dollars. The suit further states that over a 15-year period, that amount figured at 5 per cent interest (compounded annually) totals \$10.4 billion. The suit states that the purpose of the invasion was to kill or destroy the ethnic Serbs living in the area purely for ethnic reasons. The forty-page suit goes on to say,

MPRI/L-3 did not stop with the massacre of the civilians. They then filled the area with landmines, making the surviving Serbs afraid to try to return to their homes. Along with MPRI/L-3, Ceku, an ethnic Albanian who is also the so-called prime minister of Kosovo separatists, worked closely with MPRI military advisors in the ethnic cleansing of the Serbs from Krajina.

The background for this lawsuit against MPRI/L-3 draws on the indictment from the International Criminal Tribunal for Former Yugoslavia at The Hague. In the course of Operation Storm and the continuing related operations and/or actions, Croatian forces inflicted inhumane acts on Serb civilians and persons taking no part in hostilities, including persons placed hors de combat, causing not only mental abuse, humiliation and anguish (including threats to kill such persons or their families), but also severe physical injury, by shooting, beating, kicking and burning people, including extensive shelling of civilian areas and an aerial attack on fleeing civilians. Inhumane acts and cruel treatment were especially inflicted on the most vulnerable victims, including elderly women and civilians in hospitals.

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Human Rights Violations: Torture Then Destroy Evidence

Not only has L-3 committed genocide, but POGO, Project on Government Oversight, cites numerous other criminal charges against this corporation, including human rights violations. The company has paid more than 47 million in fines and penalties for criminal violations since 1995.

Other complaints include human rights violations, such as torturing and then covering up by destroying documents and misleading officials about the conditions at the prison.

Emad Khudhayir Shahuth al-Janabi, an Iraqi, claimed that employees of CACI International Inc. /L-3 tortured him while he was detained at Abu Ghraib prison from September 2003 to July 2004. He {Emad Khudhavar Shahuth}claims the tactics, which included punching, slamming him into walls, hanging him from a bed frame and keeping him naked and handcuffed, were largely directed by a CACI interrogator named Steven Stefanowicz, also known as “Big Steve.” He also claims the companies engaged in a cover-up by destroying documents, hiding prisoners during visits by international observers and misleading officials about operations at the prison. Crucial Military Equipment Defective

Some of the criminal investigations involve fraud (Wilhite, et al. v. L-3 Communications. Fraud). Other charges against L-3 focus on the company’s defective radio parts, as well as thousands of other substandard parts over the years to a wide range of Army and Air Force weapons systems. Stealing US Technology for Other Countries

Spying, stealing our technology, and then giving it or selling it to China has proved to be another serious problem with L-3. A Federal jury convicted Siexing Liu, AKA Steve Liu, a native of the People’s Republic of China and a former employee of L-3 Communications, of exporting sensitive U.S. military technology to the People’s Republic of China (PRC), stealing trade secrets, and lying to Federal agents. Sentencing was set for January 7, 2013.

Regarding Liu’s information theft, FBI Special Agent in Charge Michael B. Ward said, “Mr. Liu helped develop technology critical to our military, then took a computer with that information on an unauthorized trip to China to present at a conference sponsored by the Chinese government. The United States spends billions of dollars each year on research and development, and this ‘intellectual capital’ is very attractive to others. If they are able to acquire this research, they can save billions and quickly develop their own products to compete against the United States, be it in the world economic market or on the battlefield.” <http://www.speartip.com/former-l-3-communications-employee-sixing-liu-convicted-of-spying/>

A second L-3, Chi Mak, 65, was arrested on charges of taking home sensitive information related to a government project. The information linked with how submarines could avoid detection by sonar. His wife and brother were involved in helping Chi Mak obtain the information for China. The Border Watch Project

Besides the numerous complaints and lawsuits described above, L-3 must also take credit for the disastrous border watch project. In spite of large sums of money spent on cameras and other surveillance equipment for the Canadian and Mexican borders, officials found that none of the equipment worked. Problems ran the gamut from faulty equipment to missing equipment that was never put in place.

Fraud

The Real History of L-3 Communications

The history of L-3 Communications as portrayed on its website and its true origins are completely different. The company has operated under several identities, making it more difficult to trace its origins or its actions. Although L-3 has undergone several name changes, it officially became L-3 in 1997 when Wall Street investment bankers, the Lehman brothers and two former Loral executives, Frank Lanza and Robert LaPenta (L-3 stands for Lanza, LaPenta, and Lehman).

L-3 Communications Systems' does not tell the complete history of the company. According to the L-3 website, L-3 went by the name Electrospace Systems, which was built in 1984 and went by the name ESI and was based in Richardson, Texas. ESI moved to Waco on the campus of Texas State Technical College, and the Chrysler Corporation bought the company in 1987. By 1989, the organization was known as the Chrysler Technologies Airborne Systems, Inc., or CTAS. In 1996 Chrysler sold its defense assets to Raytheon Company, which eventually gave it the name Raytheon Aircraft Integration Systems. In 2002 it was sold to L-3 Communications, renamed L-3 Integrated Communications Systems with headquarters in Waco, Texas <http://www2.l-3com.com/is/waco/wacocorphistory.html>

L-3 Communications also goes by the name L-3 Services and L-3 Holdings. In 2011, L-3 Communications completed the spin-off of a publicly traded government services company, Engility Holdings. L-3 will continue its cyber, intelligence and security solutions functions, and that division will be called National Security Solutions.

L-3 Success: A Facade

On the surface, L-3 appears to be quite successful. Today, the New York based company has annual sales totaling \$12.6 billion and employs approximately 48,000 people. But in spite of its apparent success, this organization exhibits substantial problems.

In an April 29, 2008, report assessing L-3, "Outsourcing Intelligence in Iraq, a CorpWatch Report on L-3/Titan," stated that many of the L-3/Titan employees are "barely competent and several have been indicted for criminal acts." This CorpWatch report states that much of its information was obtained from anonymous whistle blowers; that is, a large number of L-3/Titan employees wanted to make known the problems within the company without fear of reprisal.

Military Duties and Private Companies

In an August 2006 special report to CorpWatch, "Intelligence in Iraq: L-3 Supplies Spy Support," Ptrap Chatterjee explains why he believes it's a terrible mistake for the military to turn over most of its work to private companies.
